Topic:

The PIMS Young Researchers Conference is the largest annual graduate student event in mathematics and statistics in Western Canada and the Pacific Northwest. The main objectives are (a) for young researchers to improve their scientific presentation skills by presenting their research to an audience of peers, (b) facillitate the exchange of research ideas between young researchers of different universities, and (c) give young researchers a chance to start building up an academic network.

Methodology:

The core of this event are the numerous presentations by our participants, which lead to discussions between our participants and the invited plenary speakers. The plenary speakers gave a talk themsleves to lead by example, and most of them agreed to stay for the entire duration of the conference to provide feedback and advice to our participants. Additionally, we hosted workshops on networking and academic writing, as well as a panel discussion on the pros and cons of an academic career between industry members and professors of the University of Alberta. Finally, we hosted a welcome barbecue and a conference dinner on the first and last night of the conference, respectively, to set the right tone for the social side of our event.

Objectives Achieved:

We achieved all our main objectives, partially due to the generous support of our sponsors. The generous funding made it possible to provide travel grants to 26 students from 10 universities across Canada and the United States, resulting in a very diverse range of participants. We are very grateful to our plenary speakers: their kind gesture of attending the entire conference and dedicating their time and wisdom to a new generation of young mathematicians and statisticians was immensely helpful in achieving our conference goals.
